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NOTES ABOUT PLAYER REGISTRATION

This player registration form is used to register players as members of Crewe & Nantwich Korfball Club. Please hand completed forms to the Club Secretary. There is a separate form for under-18s.

Use of your data:

Completed forms are scanned-in and stored securely in an electronic format on the club's Gmail account with hard copies disposed of confidentially. Only members of the club's Executive Committee have access to the Gmail account.

What happens next?

The Club Secretary enters your details into an online system called 'Fixtures Live', which is used for all korfball player registration and match details in England. Registration on 'Fixtures Live' is required in order for you to be eligible to play in league fixtures under England Korfball rules.

Once your record on Fixtures Live has been created you will be sent log-in details to access the system. You will then need to complete the final stage of registration, which is to upload a passport-style photograph for player verification. Please speak to the Club Secretary if you encounter any problems with the system.

You will also be sent a welcome email and added to the Club's email contact list to receive information about matches, social events and other club news (you may opt out of this at any time).

Further information

To help new members feel welcome we've produced a booklet of information, which you'll be given when you join the club. This gives more information about the club, explains what being a member of the club means, and what opportunities there are to play in different competitions and get involved as a volunteer.
