NOTES ABOUT PLAYER REGISTRATION

This player registration form is used to register players are members of Crewe & Nantwich Korfball Club. Please hand completed forms to the Club Secretary.

Use of your child's information:

Completed forms are stored securely in an electronic format on the club's Gmail account with hard copies disposed of confidentially. Only members of the club's Executive Committee have access to the Gmail account.

What happens next?

A separate form is required by the England Korfball Association (EKA) for under-age players.

New players are sent log-in details for 'Fixtures Live': an online system used for all korfball player registration and match details in England. Anyone over the age of 14 can play in competitive fixtures.

Registration on 'Fixtures Live' is required in order for players to be eligible to play in league fixtures under EKA rules. A registration email will be sent to the email address provided with instructions on how to complete registration on Fixtures Live. A passport-style photograph needs to be uploaded for player verification, however this doesn't appear on the public-facing version of the website — it is only seen by league administrators.

What does membership mean?

Members have the following privileges:

- Participation in competitions such as SaCKa (Staffordshire & Cheshire Korfball Association)
 league and cup matches and summer tournaments
- Third party insurance for competitive matches
- Voting rights at the Club's Annual General Meeting (AGM), usually in June
- The right to stand for election to the Executive Committee
